Among the many collaborations between Britten and WH Auden are several songs in a 'cabaret' style. Four of these, composed between the late 1930s and early 1940s, were published in 1980, four after Britten's death: 'Tell me the Truth About Love', 'Funeral Blues', 'Johnny' and 'Calypso'. They were written for the singer Hedli Anderson, a friend of Britten's and a performer with a remarkable vocal range.
