According to Claude Pruitt, who wrote “Circling Meaning in Toni Morrison’s ‘Sula,’” Freudian theory suggests that while all the men from the Bottom signify varying degrees of a castration complex, Jude’s is revealed when he “buries emasculation in self pity... all are without power, economically and socially castrated, just as their characters are symbolically castrated” (Pruitt 120).
