There is more to consider about Jesus than you could ever exhaust in a lifetime. Yet in verse one of

chapter three the writer of Hebrews once again asks that we “consider ...Christ Jesus.” In fact it in the original language it is an imperative, which makes it a command! The word “consider” means that we are “to fix the mind upon Jesus Christ.”

One central theme of the epistle to the Hebrews is the absolute superiority of Jesus to all who came before Him. This Jesus is worthy of much more glory than either the angels or Moses (1:1-3:6). He brings the final Sabbath rest to the people of God (3:7-4:13) and supersedes the Aaronic priesthood (4:14-7:28).
