Assessment vs Evaluation in education ...

Teachers may elect to have students self-correct. The teacher collects assessment results to monitor individual student

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progress and to inform future instruction. Both student and teacher can quickly assess whether the student acquired the intended knowledge and skills. This is a formative assessment, so a grade is not the intended purpose.

Assessment is made to identify the level of performance of an individual, whereas evaluation is performed to determine the degree to which goals are attained. The basic difference between assessment and evaluation lies in the orientation, i.e. while the assessment is process oriented, evaluation is product oriented.

Summative assessment also uses quizzes, tests, or other evaluation tools, but the intended purpose is different. In summative assessment the primary goal is to determine how much the student has learned. It is generally given at the end of an instructional topic to measure retention of that content.
