You have noticed that the compound noun can be written either as a single word, as a word with a hyphen, or as two words. There are no clear rules about this. A good rule of thumb is to write the most common compound nouns as one word, and the others as two words. The elements in a compound noun are very diverse parts of speech.

### Compound nouns - EF

A collective noun (e.g., team, group, herd) is a word that denotes a group of people or things. A collective noun looks singular, but it can be treated as singular or plural depending on whether the word refers to the group as a single entity or to its members as individuals.

### Collective Nouns | What Are Collective Nouns?

Many compound nouns end in -s, but they are all singular nouns. Example: el paraguas the umbrella; verb + noun. The majority of compound nouns are a combination of a verb and a noun. The third person singular of the verb in the present indicative is combined with a plural noun.
