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Personal Finance Activity: Hands-on, Include Answers ...

A Common Rule of Thumb. Use the 50-20-30 rule to manage spending. Apply 50% of your take-home pay to needs such as the mortgage, rent, utilities, groceries or transportation, 20% to savings, investments, and debt payments, and no more than 30% to your wants or flexible spending, such as travel or entertainment.
