A timing chain is made of metal, similar to a bicycle chain. A timing chain runs inside the engine, as it needs to be lubricated by the engine oil. A timing belt typically needs to be replaced between 40,000 and 100,000 miles depending on the vehicle. It's a few hundred dollar repair. A timing chain doesn't need to be replaced unless there is a problem with it. Is the timing chain immune to mechanical failures?

When does the timing chain need to be replaced?

Replacing the timing chain is a complicated job, and the labor costs can be quite high. For most cars, a timing chain replacement costs between \$413 and \$1040, or you can order the parts themselves for \$88 and \$245. It is a tricky repair though, so unless you're particularly skilled it's usually best left to a mechanic.

Once the timing chain is exposed, the engine is then rotated until the marks on the teeth of the timing chain are aligned. Loosening the tension gear, the chain will be removed with a screwdriver so that the mechanic will be able to remove the timing chain correctly. When the teeth are aligned and the existing timing chain is removed, the gear will be lubricated before the new chain is installed. Once lubricated, the new timing chain is placed on the gears, carefully making sure it aligns as ...

To install the timing chain with no slack between each shaft (cam, crank), follow the below procedure. Crankshaft sprocket (A) → Timing chain guide (B) → Intake CVVT sprocket (C) → Exhaust CVVT sprocket (D). The timing marks of each sprocket should be matched with timing marks (color link) of timing chain when installing the timing chain. 6.
